What information do we hold about you?



When you sign up for a CVT Connect account we hold some information about you.

Why do we need this information?

We need this information to make sure you are either supported by or employed by CVT.

To keep your account private and allow you to access your account.

To enable us to contact you about your account.

So you can create a personal profile.

To allow you to share your profile with other approved users.





The legal basis for us using this information is that by signing up to CVT Connect you give your consent for us to do so.

Who might we share your information with?



CVT connect has administrators who can view the information you provide.

You may also choose to share your profile with other users of CVT Connect.

The information you add to themed walls will be shared with others who have also joined that wall.



There are some situations in which we may need to share information with people outside of CVT. We only do this when required by our commissioners or CQC, or we are required by law or a court.

Where practicable, this will be discussed with you before it is done. We want you to be able to trust the people who support you and know that they are not going to talk or share information about you with others without you understanding why it is happening and have the opportunity to object.
